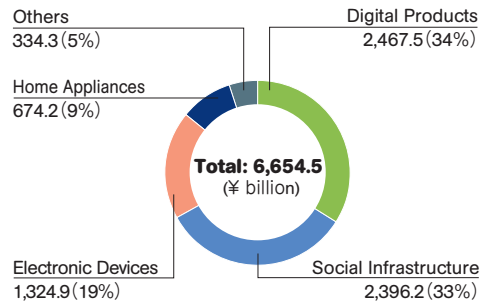


# Toshiba Pursues Innovation to Provide New Values to People and Society

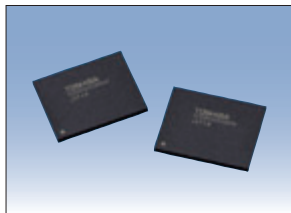
## Sales by Business Segment (FY2008)

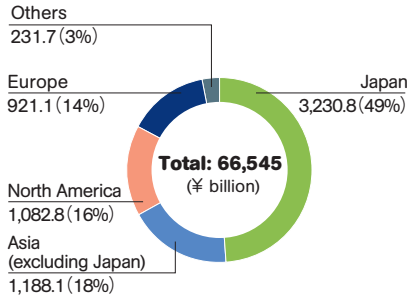

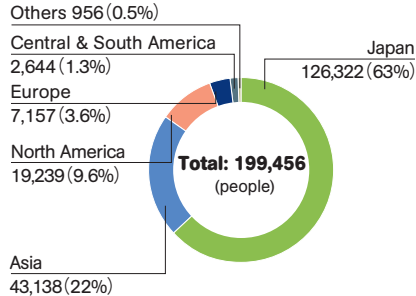

### Sales by Region (FY2008)



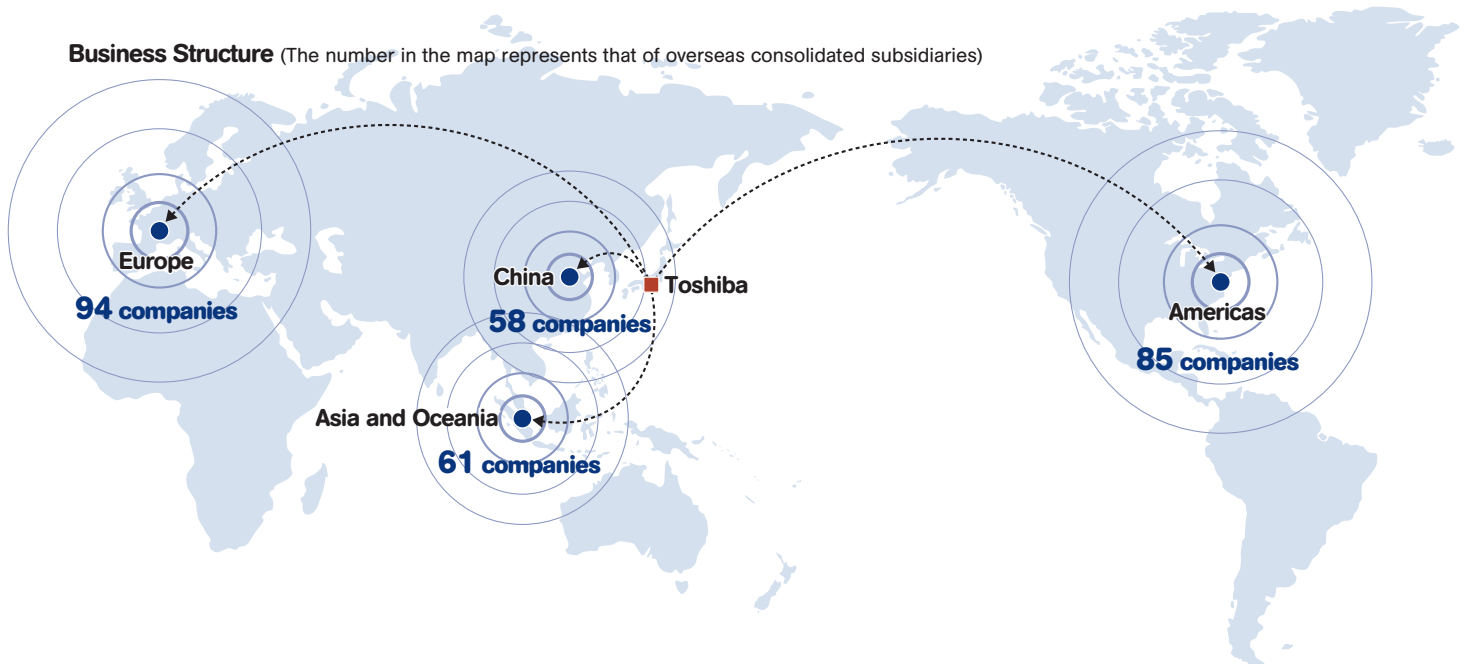
### No. of Employees by Region (as of March 31, 2009)



As in fiscal 2007, overseas sales exceeded sales in Japan, at 51%. As for the sales by region, Asia accounted for a significant proportion.

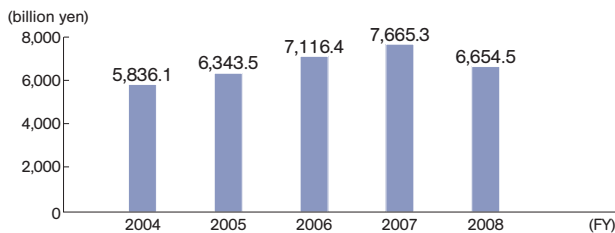
Of the 200,000 employees, those in Japan account for approximately 60% of the total, as semiconductor and social infrastructure operations are mostly based in Japan.

### Business Structure (The number in the map represents that of overseas consolidated subsidiaries)

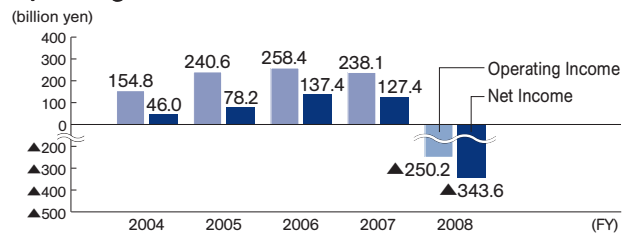
